PERMISSION FOR MASS OUTSIDE OF A SACRED PLACE (from Chancery Bulletin #293:XI; August 2006)

As a reminder, the normal place for the celebration of Mass is a sacred place, such as a Catholic church, oratory, or shrine. Permission must be obtained from the Vicar General/Chancellor to celebrate any **public** Masses outside of a sacred place. General permission is given for priests to celebrate **private** Masses outside of a sacred place. For example, on his day off, a priest may celebrate Mass in a private home with friends or family.
