E. Continuing Development and Formation

F.	Term of Agreement
Thi	s is a (new/renewed) agreement for the period ofyear(s) which will commence on and will conclude on
	1. New agreements are in effect for one year; renewal agreements may have duration of one to three years at the discretion of the <u>Pastor/Pastoral Leader and Deacon</u> .
	2. Revision Agreement revisions <u>can be made</u> for changes in the <u>Deacon's</u> health, family, employment or parish needs. Changes in <u>Pastor/Pastoral Leader may necessitate</u> revisions to the agreement. Revisions <u>can be made</u> during the agreement term with the agreement of the <u>Pastor/Pastoral Leader and Deacon</u> . An updated agreement <u>must be sent</u> to the <u>Diaconate Director</u> .
	3. Termination After consultation with the <u>Diaconate Director</u> , a request for termination of this agreement <u>must</u> <u>be given in writing</u> to the appropriate parties 60 days prior to the desired termination date. Termination may be initiated for just cause. The final decision on diaconal assignments is made by the <u>Bishop</u> .
G.	Financial Provisions For A Parish Deacon (updated annually on July 1 by the Diocese)
	 The Deacon will receive the current diocesan mileage rate for the parish related travel. A parish or institution with an assigned deacon shall budget an annual continuing development and formation allowance per deacon as set forth by the Diocese. The parish will pay toward the cost of the annual retreat for the Deacon and his wife at the rate
	set forth by the Diocese. 4. The parish will pay to the Department of Diaconate the annual sum of \$200.00 per deacon who retains his faculties (active or senior status) as set forth by the Diocese.
	5. The Deacon is entitled to any compensation that exceeds the standard stole fees for baptisms, marriages, funerals, etc.
	6. The parish is free to pay the Deacon any additional compensation it sees fit as negotiated by the parties involved.
