

*“As public restrictions are lifted and the Dispensation to Attend Sunday Mass is lifted, most COVID related guidelines are no longer applicable to liturgies in the Diocese of Green Bay. Particularly we would ask parishes to uphold the following:*

- 1. Masks continue to be highly encouraged at Mass.*
- 2. For the distribution of Holy Communion, it would be prudent for ordinary and extra-ordinary ministers of Holy Communion – especially if they have not been vaccinated – to continue to wear a mask during the distribution of Holy Communion.*
- 3. Until further notice, Holy Communion under the species of the Precious Blood is not to be distributed. A revised Diocesan policy on the distribution of the Precious Blood will be forthcoming. In the case of concelebration of a Mass, concelebrating priests should receive the Precious Blood by intinction and the main celebrant may consume the Precious Blood in the Chalice.”*
