## Response

Side 2 We pray to have the faith and confidence in God that Joseph had.

Side 1 "She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from

their sins."

Side 2 We give thanks for Jesus who is always saving us from our sins.

Side 1 "When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord had directed him and received her

into his home as his wife."

Side 2 What a man of faith Joseph was. We pray to grow daily in our love of Jesus whose

birth we remember each Advent and Christmas.
