Introduction

Opening Prayer

Word of God Matthew 28:16-20

Reader A reading from the Gospel of Matthew *(After the reading pause for silent reflection)*

Optional Discuss these questions in two’s or three’s. ***The reading is on the reverse side***

- 1 What are some ways you deal with doubts about your faith that bring you closer to God?
2. How does Jesus’ promise—“I will be with you always”—strengthen you?

Response (Taken from Matthew 28:16-20)

Side 1 “When they saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted.”

Side 2 Take our doubt and transform it to deeper faith.

Side 1 “All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me.”

Side 2 Lord, use your power through my efforts to spread your goodness everywhere.

Side 1 “Behold I am with you always, until the end of the age.”

Side 2 This is Jesus’ promise that we can rest in throughout our lives.

Petitions Individuals add intentions to remember here.

All Loving God, Jesus has asked us to spread your plan for us throughout the world. We thank you for his presence with us always so that we can deepen our resolve to do as he has commanded. We pray with confidence through the Holy Spirit. Amen.
