Response	Taken from Mark 1:12-15
Side 1	"Jesus remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan."
Side 2	Lord, because you were tempted, we know that you will help us when we are tempted.
Side 1	"He was among wild beasts, and the angels ministered to him."
Side 2	Send your angels to minister to us when we are in grave need.
Side 1	"The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the gospel."
Side 2	During this Lent, we are once again asked by God to repent and believe in the gospel.
