Response (from John 4:39-42)

Side 1 "Many of the Samaritans of that town began to believe in Jesus because of the word of the woman who testified."

Side 2 The Samaritan woman spread her amazement of Jesus. May our lives testify to our belief in

Jesus with such courage.

Side 1 "When the Samaritans came to him, they invited him to stay with them."

Side 2 Since the Samaritans were considered unbelievers, may we recognize their hospitality as an

example for our own welcome.

Side 1 "We know that this is truly the savior of the world."

Side 2 We give thanks for Jesus, our savior, but also savior of the whole world.

John 4:9-10. 25-26, 39-42 (Samaritan Woman at the Well----shortened)

The Samaritan woman said to him, "How can you, a Jew, ask me, a Samaritan woman, for a drink?"

(For Jews use nothing in common with Samaritans.)

Jesus answered and said to her,
"If you knew the gift of God and who is saying to you,
'Give me a drink,' you would have asked him
and he would have given you living water."

The woman said to him,

"I know that the Messiah is coming the one called the Anointed; when he comes, he will tell us everything."

Jesus said to her, "I am he, the one who is speaking with you."

Many of the Samaritans of that town began to believe in Jesus because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me everything I have done."

When the Samaritans came to him they invited him to stay with them; and he stayed there two days.

Many more began to believe in him because of his word, and they said to the woman, "We no longer believe because of your word; for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is truly the savior of the world."
