Optional: Discuss these questions in two's or three's. The reading is on the reverse side.

- 1. When have you known Jesus' love for you most concretely?
- 2. What helps you pay closer attention to God's messages of love for you?

### **Response** (From John 14:15-21)

- Side 1 "I will not leave you orphans. I will come to you."
- Side 2 In our great need, we ask you Lord to come to us and be with us.
- Side 1 "You will realize that I am in my Father and you are in me and I am in you."
- Side 2 Such intimate words of Jesus shake our apathy and bring us deep joy.
- Side 1 "Whoever loves me will be loved by my Father and I will love him and reveal

myself to him."

Side 2 If we ponder these words of Jesus, and believe them, we will be energized and

renewed each day.

**Petitions** Individuals add intentions to remember here.

God our Father, we rejoice in Jesus' invitation to recognize how loved we are. Fill us with your Holy Spirit so we can live in that love and share it generously. We ask this in Jesus' name. Amen.
