Introduction

Opening Prayer

All Father, you call us to walk in the light of Christ. Free us from darkness and fear
that keep us from trusting in your goodness and love. Strengthen us in the
confidence that Jesus' life, death and resurrection bring us. We ask this in the
name of Jesus, who lights our way. Amen.

Word of God Matthew 10:28-33

Reader A reading from the Gospel of Matthew (Pause for silent reflection)

Optional: Discuss these questions in two's or three's. *The reading is on the reverse side.*

1. What gives you confidence and courage in challenging situations?
2. How can your parish community emphasize ways to live out these teachings of Jesus: to trust in him and the dignity of each person?

Response (From Matthew 10:26-33)

Side 1 "Fear no one. What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light."

Side 2 In our lives we know struggles. But Jesus says to be bold.

Side 1 "Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul."

Side 2 Lord, help us believe and be at peace.

Side 1 "Even all the hairs of our head are counted, so do not be afraid."

Side 2 We thank you, God, for the gifts of courage and trust.

Petitions Individuals add intentions to remember here.

Closing Prayer

All We thank you, Father, for the gift of Jesus who teaches us to trust him at all times
and to respect the dignity of each person. Continue to teach us so we can live lives
of grace in the light of Christ. We give thanks in his name. Amen.
