GREEN BAY, Wis. (June 24, 2013) – Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Green Bay has announced a \$1 million hole-in-one prize at its 21st Annual Catholic Charities Spalding Golf Outing. A lucky contestant will have an opportunity to take a shot at the prize sponsored in part by WPS Health Insurance. The golf outing will be held Monday, July 15, at NorthBrook Country Club in Luxemburg.

Proceeds will benefit Catholic Charities, a non-profit social services agency of the Diocese of Green Bay that provides services based on Christian values to individuals, families and the community in 16 counties throughout northeast Wisconsin.
