

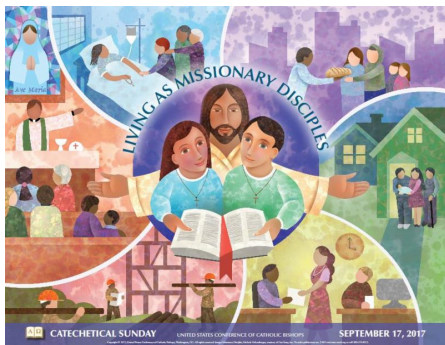

Certificate ceremony and light refreshments to follow Mass.



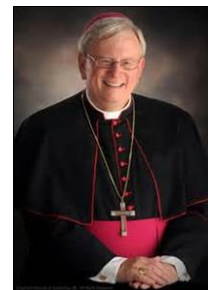

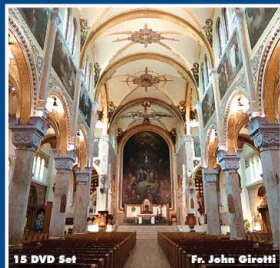

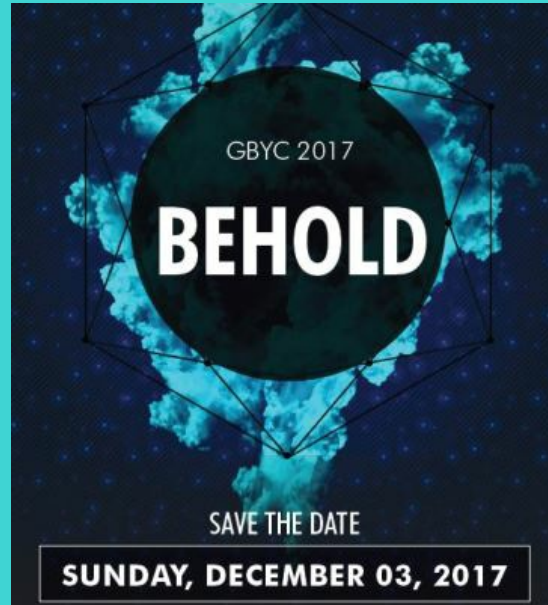
