- Schools **are not** permitted to post vacancies that instruct candidates to go to a different application system (i.e, school website).
- Remember to change the contact information when you start a new vacancy. The default is Sr. Kay's information.

If anyone has a teacher on staff or are interviewing and they need a few more hours to be full time, please make the appropriate contact.

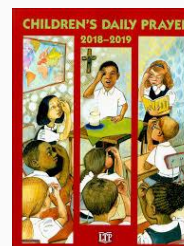
