Parvuli Dei: (Grades 3-6) The Parvuli Dei emblem is a recognition that the Catholic Church presents Cub and Webelos Scouts for

Ad Altare Dei (Grades 7-8) The purpose of the Ad Altare Dei program is to equip the Scout to take his place in the world as a maturing Catholic and a maturing American. The requirements center on the sacraments.
